


The staff would appreciate if you are able to -

- During hot weather, please apply sunscreen before school and provide sunscreen for use throughout the day. Staff will support pupils to apply the sunscreen if required. Please label the sunscreen with your child's name.
- Ensure that your child's school reading books/packs are in school every day if applicable.

Attendance

Good school attendance is a high priority for Tremains Primary School. All absences are monitored internally and externally by the Education Welfare Officer who visits the school each month.





Many parents discuss the importance of being in school on time with their children and set morning routines that support good time keeping and arrival at school on time.

To support good attendance, if your child is well enough, and has been prescribed medication, <u>four or more times a day</u>, we will happily administer a dose during the school day. Please contact the school office for the necessary consent form.
